### Please would everyone follow the guidelines below:-

1. Only 2 people to sit in each pew that is open (or one household and if room a single person). Every other pew will be cordoned off.
2. Hand sanitiser which will be by the door to be used when you enter and leave.
3. Masks should be worn in church (unless exempt), where there may be other people present; remembering that they are mainly intended to protect other people, not the wearer, from coronavirus COVID-19 and that they are not a replacement for physical distancing and regular hand washing.
4. For the moment no refreshments will be served but do feel free to bring a water bottle with you.
5. It is asked that you do not spend too long in the church building after the service as it has to be cleaned and sanitised.
6. At Capel the toilet will be open and disinfectant available for you to wipe all surfaces after it has been used.
7. Unfortunately, we cannot sing hymns but there will be music from our organists, choir, musicians and some recorded music as appropriate
8. The services will be on a sheet given to you when you enter the church along with the weekly sheet, please take these home with you.
9. No collection will be taken but donations can be left on the plate. OR for those who have a smart phone, an alternative way to give is to download the Givt app and use that to donate instead of cash. *Any queries on Givt - please speak to Dineke, Debbie or Helen.* Thank you.
