3. For the moment no refreshments will be served but do feel free to bring a water bottle with you.

4. It is asked that you vacate the church quickly after the service as it has to be cleaned and sanitised.

5. At Capel the toilet will be open and disinfectant available for you to wipe all surfaces after it has been used.

6. Unfortunately, we cannot sing hymns but there will be music from our organists, musicians and some recorded music as appropriate

7. The services will be on a sheet given to you when you enter the church along with the weekly sheet, please take these home with you.

8. No collection will be taken but donations can be left on the plate. OR for those who have a smart phone, an alternative way to give is to download the Givt app and use that to donate instead of cash.

9. Holy communion is given in one kind (wafer) and all necessary hygiene precautions are taken.
