



7. The services will be on a sheet given to you when you enter the church along with the weekly sheet, please take these home with you.

8. No collection will be taken but donations can be left on the plate. OR for those who have a smart phone, an alternative way to give is to download the Givt app and use that to donate instead of cash.

9. Holy communion is given in one kind (wafer) and all necessary hygiene precautions are taken.
