#### Please observe the following guidelines whilst in church:

We have designated the front pews for those who would like to sing during the service. These pews will have hymn books, prayer books and kneelers available. Please leave the books in the pew when you leave. Please continue to wear your masks when singing. The back pews are available for those who would prefer not to sing and maintain more social distance.

**At Capel:** One of the hymns (usually the 3<sup>rd</sup>) will be designated as an offertory hymn. The bag will be passed round by the sidesperson but should not be handled by others.

**At Ockley:** The collection plate will be on the table at the back of the church for donations.
