**Please observe the following guidelines whilst in church:**

**At both churches:**

**At Capel:** One of the hymns (usually the 3<sup>rd</sup>) will be designated as an offertory hymn. The bag will be passed round by the sides person.

**At Ockley:** The collection plate will be on the table at the back of the church for donations.
