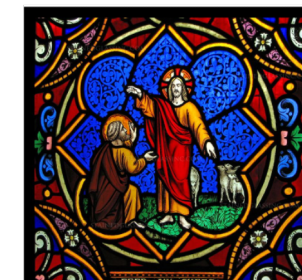

Please observe the following guidelines whilst in church:

At both churches:
