May they know the loving presence of Christ in their hearts. We pray especially for Jennifer, Tessa, Philomena, Nicky, Nick, George, Sally, Doreen, Joy, Shirley, Dianne and Hannah. Loving God, we commend to you those who have served your Son here on earth and now celebrate his victory with him in heaven and we pray for those most recently bereaved - the family and friends of Eric Sutcliffe.
