We come to God, knowing that we are welcome to enter God's presence through the grace of the Son. As God's people we have the privilege of prayer. So let us bring our concerns to the Lord of all. We pray for the church; that God's people might have a heart for those outside the kingdom and seek ways to make God's love known. We pray for those at a loss about the way ahead, perhaps on the brink of an important decision; that the Lord will give them wisdom. We pray for those whose loss cannot be recovered: loss of a loved one, a job, a relationship or health; that the Lord will bring them comfort. We pray for ourselves, and the parts inside us that feel lost, asking that the Lord will meet us at our point of deepest need.

We pray for all those who suffer in body, mind or spirit and especially for Jennifer, Tessa, Philomena, Nicky, Nick, George, Sally, Doreen, Joy, Shirley, Dianne, Hannah, Margaret, Artie, Chris and Pete. We pray for the family and friends of Barbara King and also of William King (no relation) who died recently, remembering all those who are approaching the end of their earthly lives and those who watch with them. Bring comfort and healing dear Lord. Lord God, we thank you that you listen with love and respond with power to the concerns in our hearts so we let them rest in your care.

We wish God's richest blessings and our congratulations to Tomio and Masako Shimoyama who came to St John's on Saturday afternoon for their marriage to be blessed in front of family and friends. Tomio and Masako were married a few months ago in Japan. May their marriage be life giving and life long. We thank them too for the beautiful flowers arranged in their honour - do pop into church and see them - they are simply beautiful.
