The Friends of Capel Church AGM is to be held at Capel Church on Sunday 19th April at 12pm. All are welcome.

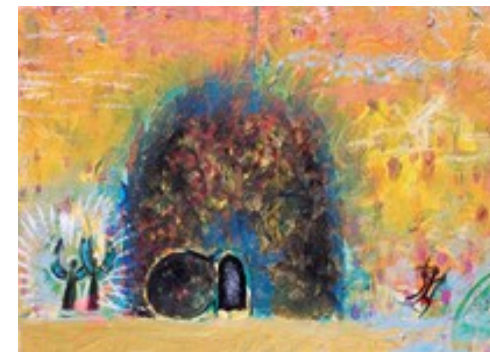
